

### **Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA)**

**RCIA is a journey of faith through which interested adults grow in their relationship with God, become familiar with Catholic teachings and practices, and get acquainted with people in the parish. RCIA is recommended for anyone who is interested in joining the Catholic faith or anyone who may have been baptized Catholic, but did not receive the Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, Confirmation, and Eucharist). The journey culminates with full reception into the Catholic Church during the Easter Vigil, receiving the Sacraments of Initiation. Parishioners who would like to be a sponsor, or desire information for participants, call the Director of Religious Education. This is a great way of participating in spreading the Good News.**

### **Rite of Christian Initiation of Children (RCIC)**

**This process is for un-baptized children who are old enough to learn their faith, and for those of an older age who have been baptized as infants, but who have not received religious education or receive the Sacraments of Reconciliation, Eucharist, or Confirmation.
